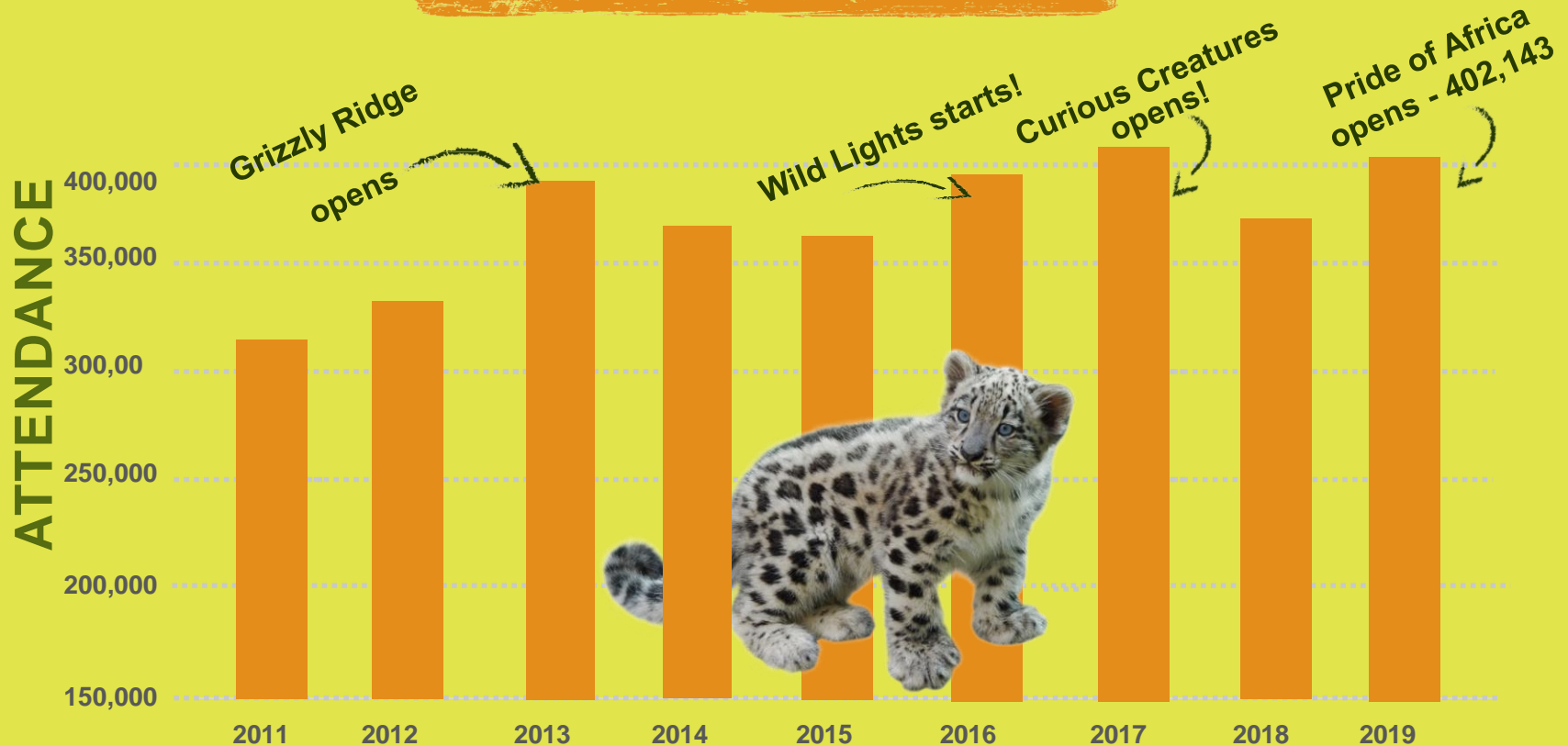

NOVEMBER 2020

This is the first time since our original levy passed 20 years ago that the zoo is asking for an increase.

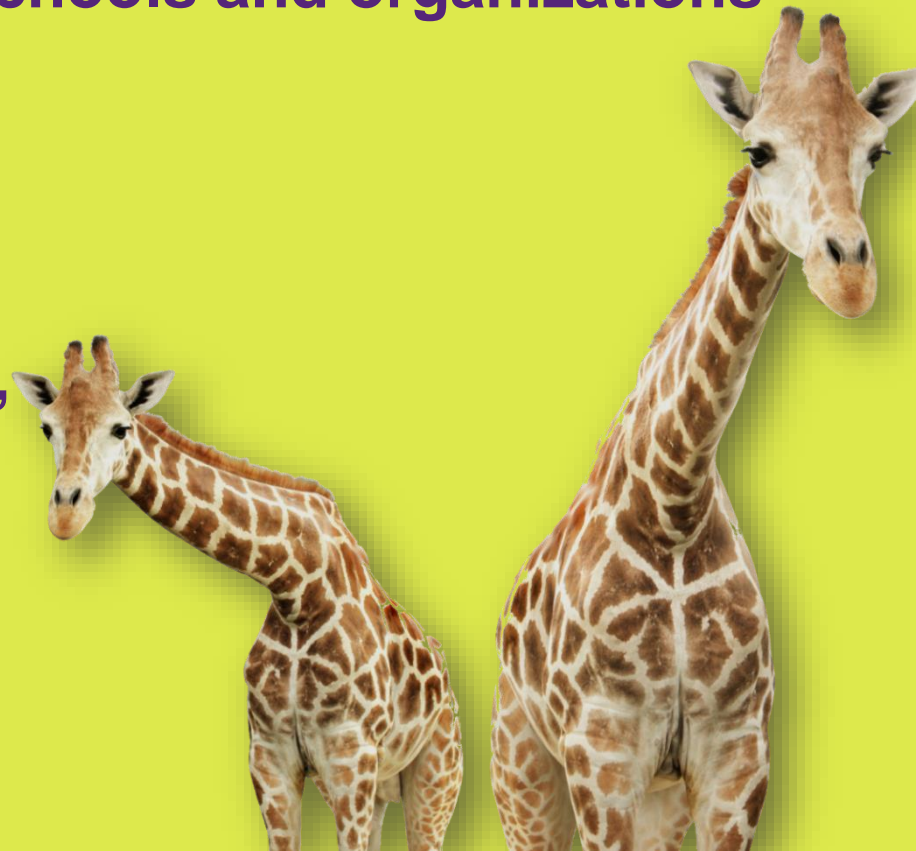
